

# COLUMBIA, N.Y.U. GAIN IN FENCING

## Both Qualify 3 Swordsmen for N.C.A.A.'s 2d Round

**COLORADO SPRINGS, March 18**—The defending champion New York University fencing team was one of 12 schools to qualify all three of its fencers in today's opening round of the National Collegiate championships at the Air Force Academy. The final two rounds will be held tomorrow and Saturday.

N.Y.U., which has won a record total of eight N.C.A.A. crowns, qualified Ed Ballinger in foil, George Szunyogh in épée and Steve Kaplan in saber.

Columbia, the Ivy League champion, which finished second to N.Y.U. in this meet last year, also sent three men into the second round. They were the defending saber champion, Bruce Soriano; Mark Haselkorn in épée and Bob Berger in foil.

"The next two days will be the key test," said Hugo Castello, the N.Y.U. coach. "The key to the meet will be how many teams can qualify three fencers for Saturday's round."
