**National Collegiate Fencing Awards**

From 1951 until 1967, the Illinois Memorial Trophy was presented annually to the "Fencer of the Year" selected from participants in the National Collegiate Championships. Since 1968, however, the Trophy has been presented to the top foil participant in the NCAA meet.

In 1968, the Michigan State Memorial Trophy was established for the top saber performer, and the Princeton-Cornell Memorial Trophy was established for the top epee participant. The trophies are awarded on the basis of sportsmanship and conduct on the strip, attitude and dress, past performances in the Championships and in over-all intercollegiate competition. The three winners are selected by the student-athletes participating in the Championships.

**1971 Championships**

NEW YORK UNIVERSITY won its fourth NCAA championship in the last six years, but this season had to share the title with Columbia as each scored 68 points. It was NYU's ninth team championship and Columbia's eighth.

The Violets showed strongest in the epee and saber where they had an individual champion and a runner-up. George Scunyogh won

the epee competition with a 20-3 record while Steve Kaplan was second in the saber with a 19-4 mark.

Columbia's champion was Bruce Soriano who had a 23-0 mark to win his second straight saber title. Meanwhile, Tyrone Simmons of Detroit broke the NYU-Columbia stronghold on individual championships by winning the foil event with a 20-3 mark.
