National Collegiate Fencing Awards

From 1951 until 1967, the Illinois Memorial Trophy was presented annually to the "Fencer of the Year" selected from participants in the National Collegiate Championships. Since 1968, however, the Trophy has been presented to the top foil participant in the NCAA meet.

In 1968, the Michigan State Memorial Trophy was established for the top saber performer, and the Princeton-Cornell Memorial Trophy was established for the top epee participant. The trophies are awarded on the basis of sportsmanship and conduct on the strip, attitude and dress, past performances in the Championships and in over-all intercollegiate competition. The three winners are selected by the student-athletes participating in the Championships.

1972 Championships

DETROIT UNIVERSITY broke a 13-year Eastern stranglehold on the National Collegiate Fencing Championships, earning its first team title in that sport at the University of Illinois, Chicago Circle. The Titans edged New York University, a nine-time champion, 73-70 for the crown.

Tyrone Simmons won the foil competition with a 23-0 mark to pace Detroit. It was Simmons' second straight foil title. Mean-

while, Columbia's Bruce Soriano became the first three-time champion in the 28-year history of the championships by copping the saber title with a 23-1 mark. Ernesto Fernandez of Pennsylvania upset defending titlist George Szunyogh of NYU in epee competition, posting a 21-2 record. That upset and Detroit's depth gave the Titans their three-point winning margin.
