National Collegiate Fencing Awards

From 1951 until 1967, the Illinois Memorial Trophy was presented annually to the "Fencer of the Year" selected from participants in the National Collegiate Championships. Since 1968, however, the Trophy has been presented to the top foil participant in the NCAA meet.

In 1968, the Michigan State Memorial Trophy was established for the top saber performer, and the Princeton-Cornell Memorial Trophy was established for the top epee participant. The trophies are awarded on the basis of sportsmanship and conduct on the strip, attitude and dress, past performances in the Championships and in over-all intercollegiate competition. The three winners are selected by the student-athletes participating in the Championships.

1973 Championships

NEW YORK UNIVERSITY returned the National Collegiate Fencing Championship to the east coast after a one-year absence when it picked up its third national title in the past five years at Johns Hopkins University.

The national champions compiled 76 points in the competition to runner-up Pennsylvania's 71. Wayne State (Mich.) scored 64 points to edge cross-town rival Detroit by one point for third place.

In spite of the fact that he finished second to Brooke Makler of Pennsylvania in the foil competition, Tyrone Simmons of Detroit was named winner of the Illinois Trophy for the third straight year.

The championship returned to New York University mainly on the strength of wins in saber by Peter Westbrook and in epee by Risto Hurme, both of NYU.
