

WEST POINT FENCERS WIN

Capture Intercollegiate Championship for Second Year.

Cadets Breckinridge and Honeycutt, with Clark of Columbia, Tie for Individual Honors.

The team representing West Point won the intercollegiate fencing championship for the second consecutive time last night in the gymnasium of the New York Athletic Club and thereby secured the championship trophy presented by the Racquet and Tennis Club. Columbia finished second, Cornell third, Yale fourth, Pennsylvania fifth, and Harvard last. Three men tied for the individual championship, Cadets Breckinridge and Honeycutt and F. B. Clark of Columbia each winning thirteen of the fifteen bouts in which they participated. Col. R. M. Thompson had given a medal for the individual championship, but he decided to give all three men medals.

Although Columbia was beaten for the championship, her team succeeded in winning the majority of the bouts with West Point. W. E. Withrow, the new member of the team, fenced surprisingly well, and it was his defeat of Breckinridge that enabled Clark to tie for first place.

The men fenced on a raised platform in the centre of the gymnasium, only one bout being contested at a time. The bouts were witnessed by a large gallery of spectators, many of whom were women.

The last bout of the evening was the best of the competition, which began on Friday and was continued yesterday afternoon. It was between Clark and Breckinridge. Breckinridge had only met with one defeat, while Clark had twice failed to get the decision. The judges failed to agree at the conclusion of the bout and the referee ordered an extra period. Clark was the more aggressive in this and won the decision. Summary:
