Championship With Sabre in Tournament at Hotel Astor. ALSO WINS FOILS TITLE

Takes Intercollegiate Team

The Navy's veteran team of fencers made a clean sweep of the intercollegiate fencing championships which were concluded last night at the Hotel

Astor after two days of fencing. The Navy foils team, composed of Curtis Shears, Captain Alving Becker and N. M. Floyd, captured the foils team championship, and with the title, became possessor of the Colonel Robert M. Thompson bronze trophy, familiarly known as the "The Little Iron Man." Columbia, former holder of the title and the trophy, finished third. Harvard captured second honors. The scores by bouts won and lost in the team event were: Navy, 45-9; Harvard, 33-21; Columbia, 30-24; Dartmouth, 28-26; Yale, 28-26; Massachusetts Institute of Technology, 16—38; University of Pennsylvania, 9—45. In addition to winning the foils team championship, the Navy won the sable team championship and the epée title. Shears and Becker of the Navy took first and second individual honors in foils. Shears won 17 bouts and lost 1. Becker's score was 15 to 3. E. L. Lane of Harvard and Reinhold Hertzberg of Dartmouth tied for third honors, with
