NINE TEAMS ENTERED.

Will Compete in Intercollegiate Fencing Tournament Here.

The intercollegiate fencing champion-ships, to be held April 12 and 13 at the Hotel Astor, have attracted nine team entries so far. The United States Naval Academy has a strong squad prepared to defend the title it won last year, but will find keen opposition from West Point, Harvard, Yale, Cornell, Columbia, Dartmouth, M. I. T. and Pennsylvania. The cadets have entered the tournament for the first time since 1912. Each team will be composed of seven men and championships will be decided with three weapons—folls, sabres and duelling swords or épée.
