

# YALE FENCERS GAIN NEW ENGLAND TITLE

**Win All Three Matches, Beating  
Dartmouth, Harvard and  
Mass. Tech at Boston.**

## HARVARD TEAM RUNNER-UP

**Carries Off Two Victories and  
Loses One — Levis, M. I. T.,  
Picked as Best Swordsman.**

BOSTON, March 20.—By outfencing Massachusetts Institute of Technology and Harvard at the Boston A. A. clubhouse today, Yale made it three victories in a row to take the New England intercollegiate fencing championship in easy style. The Elis whipped Dartmouth yesterday, 9 to 0, and this afternoon won from Harvard, 6 to 3, and tonight defeated M. I. T., 6 to 3.

Harvard was second with two victories and one defeat, Tech was third with one victory and two defeats and Dartmouth was last with three losses.

Levis of M. I. T. was judged the best fencer, and though his team failed to win the right to compete in the national championships in New York next month, he will enter the individual matches. Allen, No. 3 on Harvard, was the only fencer in the meet to win from Levis.

A. G. Carrillo of Harvard was tied with three Yale men, Elwell, Every and Lee, for second place. As Harvard and Yale won the right to enter the national events in April, these teams will meet in competition again.

In the épée Bill Snow of Yale was judged the best performer, with Levis of Tech second, and Brown of Yale, and Outerbridge of Harvard, tied for third.

The feature match today was the Harvard and Yale series for the Big Three championship. Captain Carrillo of the Crimson team, seemed to be the only one who could give the Elis a battle, winning his three bouts.
