Yale once more evinced its supremacy in intercollegiate fencing when Eli swordsmen garnered four of the seven titles in the thirty-ninth annual championship tournament of the Intercollegiate Fencing Association, which was held over the past week-end at the Hotel Commodore.

Winning team championships épée and three-weapon, the New Haven squad also placed two individual titleholders-John F. Potter in foils and Rockwood Chin in épée. Except for the saber team crown captured by Navy, Army took the rest of the honors. The West Point foils team annexed the Iron Man trophy, emblematic of the foils team title, and Cadet Maurice Evans won the individual saber Kaiser laurels.
