

N.Y.U. to Defend Team Title In Three-Weapon Fencing

New York University's team will be the defending champion in the Intercollegiate Fencing Association three-weapon championship being held today and tomorrow at N.Y.U.'s Alumni Gymnasium in the Bronx.

Thirteen colleges will be represented in the team and individual competition in foil, épée and saber classifications.

Penn and Navy are considered impressive challengers, while Princeton, victor over the Quakers last month, is ranked as another strong contender.

Other teams entered are Army, City College, Cornell, Harvard, M.I.T., Penn State, Yale, Rutgers and Columbia, the 1968 National Collegiate champion. The Lions, however, have only one letter man, Dan Gottesman, in the saber, from the 1968 team.

The épée bouts will be held this morning and the foil during the afternoon.
