The Violets placed two fencers-Wayne Krause and George Szunyogh, the defending champions-in the épée individual championships tomorrow and qualified all three of their foil entries—Marty Lang, Ed linger and Pete Gaylor.

Individual championships in the three weapons will follow the team championships in the

saber tomorrow.

N. Y. U. had 61 team points after two weapons, followed by Columbia with 49 and Pennsylvania with 47.

Lang was the day's only undefeated fencer, winning all 12 bouts in the team foil.
