

N.Y.U. CAPTURES FENCING CROWN

Princeton Is Runner-Up in 3-Weapon Team Event— Hurme Epee Winner

New York University recaptured the Intercollegiate Fencing Association's three-weapon team championship yesterday at Alumni Gymnasium in the Bronx.

The Violets scored 81 points, 11 more than Princeton, which finished second. Columbia, the defending champion, was third with 62. Last year the Violets finished fourth.

The N.Y.U. fencers took the épée crown and tied with Pennsylvania for foil honors on Friday. Yesterday they placed fourth in the saber class as Columbia and Yale tied for first.

In the individual competition N.Y.U. took two of the three titles. Risto Hurme and Pete Westbrook posted 5—0 records to gain épée and saber honors. Brooke Makler of Penn was the foil winner.
