

N.Y.U. Leads Penn for Fencing Crown

Although it failed to capture either the epee or foil team title, New York University yesterday emerged from the first day of the two-day Intercollegiate Fencing Association championships at Columbia's Levien Gym with a three-bout lead over second-place Pennsylvania.

The saber competition is scheduled for today, along with the individual championships.

The Violets placed third in the epee and tied for second in the foil for a 52-20 record. Pennsylvania tied for fourth place in the epee competition, but won the foil event, giving the Quakers an overall 49-23 mark. Harvard, co-winner of the epee competition

with Princeton, is in third place with a 46-26 record, three bouts ahead of both the Tigers and Navy who are tied at 43 and 29.
