Pennsylvania Fencers Win 3d Straight Title

PRINCETON, N. J., March 11—Pennsylvania won its third straight Intercollegiate Fencing Association championships today in Jadwin Gymnasium.

Pennsylvania scored 90 points. New York University was second with 79.

Jack Tichacek, a Pennsylvania senior, was the only individual champion for the Quakers. He won the foil title from Rob Woodson, also a Pennsylvania senior. In the round-robin finals. both Tichacek and Woodson compiled 6-2 records, Woodson winning on more touches.

Following Pennsylvania and N.Y.U. in the final team standings were Navy, with 78 points, Princeton, with 68 points, and Rutgers, with 59 points. Pennsylvania earned the epce team itle with 32 points, N.Y.U. won the foil title with 31 points and Navy took the saber trophy with 30 points.
