

Bloomer Injured in Bout.

News has just been received from Chicago that Millard J. Bloomer, Jr., of Columbia University, national junior foils and epee champion, who recently won a place on the American Olympic fencing team, has been painfully injured in an exhibition bout on the outskirts of Chicago. Bloomer's adversary was James Knox of the Illinois A. C., who accidentally drove his duelling sword under Bloomer's guard and through the right shoulder. The blade came out after piercing the flesh for a distance of five inches. It is thought that Bloomer will recover in time to go with the Olympic team.
